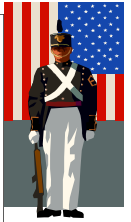

Itinerary

Day One: Early morning departure with our first stop at Howe Caverns. Visitors are offered a rare glimpse into a prehistoric world formed millions of years ago by an underground river. From there, we travel to the Holiday Inn Kingston where we'll spend the next two nights. Dinner included this evening at a local restaurant.

Day Two: Following breakfast you will travel to Hyde Park for a visit to the home of Franklin D. Roosevelt. Consisting of more than 200 acres, it includes the graves of Franklin and Eleanor Roosevelt. Next to the home lies the Franklin D. Roosevelt Library/Museum displaying photos, artwork, speeches and official documents. Following luncheon (on own), we'll visit the Vanderbilt Mansion, built in 1898. The mansion emphasizes the Beaux-Arts architecture of the late 19th-century "Gilded Age". Enjoy a one-hour tour before dinner tonight at the world-famous Culinary Institute of America.

Day Three: Following breakfast, depart hotel for a two-hour narrated cruise on the historic Hudson River. Disembarking at West Point, you will be met by your Guide for an inspiring tour of the magnificent Academy and grounds. Time for lunch (on own), before arriving at the Brotherhood Winery where you will enjoy a guided wine tasting tour. Following winery tour, depart for home.
